

## CAUTION

Wall fixings are not included as hanging surfaces vary.

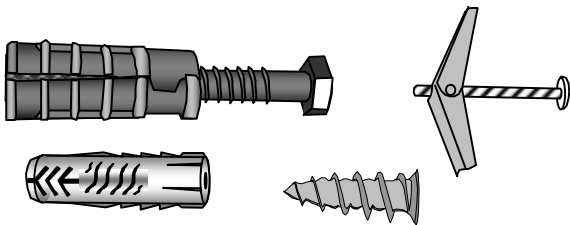
**We recommend that mirrors weighing over 10kg are hung by professionals only.**

Wall plugs and screws must be compatible with the wall construction and materials, and suitable for holding the weight of the mirror. If in doubt, seek professional advice.

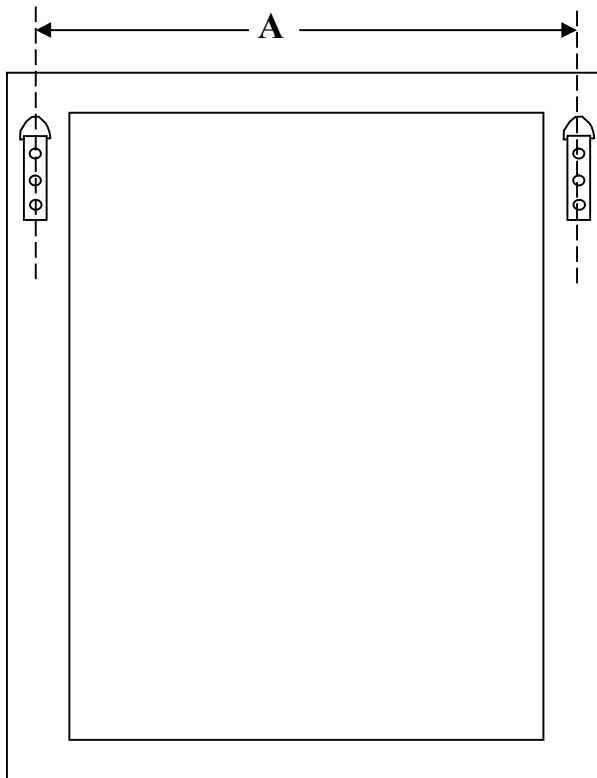
This mirror has been designed to be hung as shown below. **DO NOT** use picture wire as this will create a strain on the hangers and could result in failure of the mirror fittings.  
Failure to follow these directions may result in a safety hazard.

## MIRROR HANGING INSTRUCTIONS

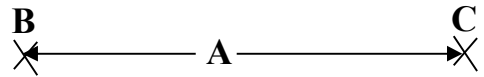
1. Choose wall anchors suitable for the type of wall (stone, brick, cavity etc.) and the size and weight of the mirror to be hung.



2. Measure the distance between the mirror hanging brackets.



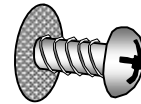
3. Measure the same distance on the wall, ensuring that the two points are level and mark the wall where the mirror is to be hung (B & C).



4. Drill holes at B and C to accept the wall anchors.

5. Insert the wall anchors.

6. Insert suitable screws/bolts, leaving approximately 1cm of the screw and screw head protruding to safely accept the mirror hanging brackets.



7. The mirror hanging brackets should be hung directly on these screws.
