DE- DAS SOLLTEN SIE ÜBER IHRE MOBEL WISSEN ! Es ist wichtig zu wissen, dass sich bei Kontakt die Farbe Ihrer Möbel je nach Verwendung und Lichtexposition verändern wird. Setzen Sie Ihre Möbel außerdem weder direkten Sonnenlicht noch Wärmequellen für längere Zeit aus, da dies zu Verfärbungen führen kann. Stellen Sie niemals nasse oder heiße Gegenstände direkt auf das Produkt, da die Ober- oder Flächen der Möbel hitzeempfindlich sind. Wir empfehlen Ihnen daher die Verwendung von Untersetzern. Bewahren Sie Montageschlüssel sorgfältig auf, um Schrauben regelmäßig nachziehen zu können, damit Ihre Möbel dauerhaft über Stabilität verfügen. Um Ihre Möbel zu reinigen, stauben Sie sie regelmäßig mit einem trockenen Tuch ab. Um Gegenstände auf Ihren Möbeln zu verschieben, ziehen Sie sie nicht über die Oberfläche, sondern heben Sie sie zur Vermeidung von Kratzern an. Versetzen Sie Ihre Möbel immer mindestens zu zweit und schieben Sie sie nicht, um Kratzer auf dem Boden zu vermeiden. Wenn Ihre Möbel Stoffelemente enthalten, kann sich die Farbe im Laufe der Zeit verändern. Dies ist eine natürliche Reaktion wenn Stoff dem Sonnenlicht ausgesetzt wird. ALLGEMEINE PFLEGE IHRER MÖBEL Nach Erhalt Ihrer Möbel, stellen Sie sicher, Türen und Schubladen in einem gut belüfteten Raum durchzulüften. Vermeiden Sie jeden Kontakt mit alkoholhaltigen Substanzen, Lösungsmitteln, Scheuermitteln, spitzen oder scharfen Gegenständen. Die Oberflächen sollten mit Reinigungsmitteln wie Bleichmitteln nicht lange in Kontakt kommen. Wenn Sie sich nicht mehr an die Beschichtung oder Werkstoffe, aus denen Ihre Möbel gefertigt sind, erinnern können, zögern Sie nicht unseren Kundendienst anzurufen!

MASSIVHOLZ Holz ist ein nachhaltiges, natürliches und lebendiges Material: das erklärt Variationen in Maserung, Farbe, Textur und das Vorhandensein von Knoten. Durch seine poröse Beschaffenheit wird es mit Zeit seines Lebens Feuchtigkeit aufnehmen und abgeben. Das Furnier besteht aus massivem Holz, das auf eine Holzplatte geklebt wurde, um eine saubere und stabile Oberfläche zu erhalten. GEÖLTES HOLZ Öl betont die Maserung des Holzes und seine Wärme, beugt jedoch nicht gegen Kratzer vor. Die Wartung muss regelmäßig durchgeführt werden, um sein Aussehen und seine Eigenschaften zu erhalten. Ölen Sie Ihr Möbelstück mindestens einmal pro Jahr mit Paraffin oder Vaseline ein, um die Poren des Holzes zu versiegeln und es resistenter gegen Luftfeuchtigkeitsänderungen zu machen. Im Falle von sehr hoher Hitze oder hoher Luftfeuchtigkeit, wiederholen Sie die Anwendung von Öl häufiger. Lassen Sie dem Holz nach jeder Anwendung Zeit, das Öl vor dem Gebrauch zu absorbieren. Entstauben Sie regelmäßig mit einem trockenen Tuch. Reinigen Sie mit einem feuchten Tuch.

Im Falle hartnäckiger Flecken: Mit feinem Sandpapier schleifen anschließend mit einer Öl-Anwendung fortfahren. Keine Reiniger mit Lösemittel oder Scheuermittel verwenden.

UK - WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT YOUR FURNITURE! It's important to know that the colour of your furniture will change depending on how it's used and its exposure to light. Try to avoid exposing your furniture to direct sunlight or heat sources for extended periods, this could cause discolouration. Never place wet or hot items directly onto the product because the surfaces of furniture are sensitive to heat. That's why we recommend using trivets or table mats. Keep the Allen key so you can tighten the screws regularly to give your furniture permanent stability. To keep your furniture clean, dust it regularly with a dry cloth. When moving items around on your furniture, don't drag or slide them, lift them to avoid scratches. If you want to move your furniture, we recommend that you always do it with at least one other person. Don't drag it, make sure you lift it to avoid scratching your floor. If your furniture contains fabric products, the colour may alter over time, this is a natural reaction of fabrics exposed to sunlight FOR THE GENERAL MAINTENANCE OF YOUR FURNITURE Upon receipt of your furniture, be sure to air it, with the doors and drawers open, in a well-ventilated room. Avoid any contact with alcohol-based substances, solvents, abrasive materials, sharp or cutting objects. Household cleaning products such as bleach should not be left for prolonged periods on the surface. If you can't remember what kind of finish or materials have been used to make your furniture, feel free to contact our customer service!

SOLID WOOD Wood is a durable, natural, living material, which explains variations in grain, colour, texture and the presence of knots. Being naturally porous, it continues to absorb and release moisture throughout its life. Veneer is a thin sheet of solid wood glued to a wood-based panel to produce a clean, smooth surface finish. **OILED WOOD** Oil brings out the grain and warmth of the wood but does not provide protection from scratches. It needs regular care to protect its appearance and properties. Oil your furniture at least once a year with paraffin oil or Vaseline to seal the pores of the wood and make it less vulnerable to variations in humidity. If your furniture is exposed to high temperatures or lots of humidity, apply the oil more frequently. After each application, allow time for the wood to absorb the oil before using your furniture. Dust regularly with a dry cloth. Wipe with a damp cloth. In case of stubborn stains: sand with fine sandpaper and then apply a coat of oil. Don't use cleaning products containing solvents or abrasives.

IT - LE COSE CHE DEVI SAPERE SUI TUOI MOBILI! È importante sapere che la tinta dei mobili cambierà in funzione del loro uso e della loro esposizione alla luce, se sono a contatto diretto con essa. Evita di esporre i mobili a contatto diretto con i raggi solari o con fonti di calore per lunghi periodi, ciò potrebbe provocare una decolorazione dei mobili. Non collocare mai articoli bagnati o caldi direttamente sul prodotto poiché la superficie dei mobili è sensibile al caldo, ti consigliamo l'uso di un sottopiatto. Conserva la chiave di montaggio per stringere regolarmente gli assemblaggi in modo da dare al mobile una stabilità permanente. Per mantenere i mobili puliti, spolverali regolarmente con un panno asciutto. Per spostare gli oggetti sui mobili, non trascinarli ma sollevali per evitare che graffino le superfici. Per spostare un mobile, ti consigliamo di farlo in 2 o più persone, non trascinarlo ma sollevarlo per evitare che graffi il pavimento. Se il mobile contiene parti in tessuto, il colore potrebbe variare con il passare del tempo, si tratta di una reazione naturale dei tessuti esposti alla luce del sole. **PER LA MANUTENZIONE GENERALE DEI MOBILI** Dopo aver ricevuto il tuo mobile non dimenticarti di aerarlo, con le ante e i cassetti aperti, in una stanza ben ventilata. Evita qualsiasi contatto con sostanze a base di alcool, solventi, materiali abrasivi, oggetti appuntiti o taglienti. I prodotti per la pulizia della casa, come la candeggina, non devono rimanere troppo a lungo a contatto con la superficie. LEGNO MASSELLO Il legno è un materiale naturale, vivo e che si conserva nel tempo: ciò spiega le variazioni di grana, di colore, di consistenza e la presenza di nodi. Poroso di natura, il legno continua ad assorbire e a rilasciare umidità nel corso degli anni. L'impiallacciatura è un foglio di legno massello incollato su un pannello a base di legno che consente di ottenere una superficie pulita e regolare.

LEGNO OLIATO L'olio mette in risalto le venature del legno e il suo calore ma non garantisce la resistenza ai graffi. È necessario effettuare una regolare manutenzione per conservare il suo aspetto e le sue proprietà. Olia almeno una volta all'anno il mobile con olio di paraffina o di vaselina, per sigillare i pori del legno e renderlo meno sensibile alle variazioni del tasso di umidità. In caso di temperature molto elevate o di forte umidità ripeti l'applicazione d'olio più frequentemente. Dopo ogni applicazione, lascia al legno il tempo di assorbire l'olio prima di qualsiasi utilizzo. Spolvera regolarmente con un panno asciutto. Pulisci il mobile con un panno umido. In caso di macchie ostinate: levigale con della carta vetrata sottile quindi procedi ad un'applicazione d'olio.

FR - CE QU'IL FAUT SAVOIR CONCERNANT VOTRE MOBILIER ! Il est important de savoir que la teinte de vos meubles changera suivant leur utilisation et leur exposition à la lumière s'ils sont en contact direct. Aussi, évitez d'exposer vos meubles aux rayons directs du soleil ou à des sources de chaleur pendant de longues périodes, ceci pourrait provoquer une décoloration. Ne placez jamais des articles mouillés ou chauds directement sur le produit car la surface des meubles est sensible à la chaleur, nous vous conseillons l'utilisation de dessous de plat. Conserver la clé de montage pour resserrer régulièrement les assemblages afin de donner à votre meuble une stabilité permanente Pour que vos meubles restent

Pour déplacer votre meuble, nous vous conseillons de toujours le faire à 2 personnes ou plus, ne le faites pas glisser mais soulevez-le pour éviter tout risque de rayures sur votre sol. Si votre mobilier contient des parties tissus, la couleur pourrait varier au fil du temps, ceci est une réaction naturelle des tissus exposés à la lumière du soleil. POUR L'ENTRETIEN GÉNÉRAL DE VOTRE MOBILIER : À réception de votre meuble, veillez à bien l'aérer, portes et tiroirs ouverts, dans une pièce bien ventilée. Évitez tout contact avec des substances à base d'alcool, de solvants, des matériaux abrasifs, des objets pointus ou tranchants. Les produits nettoyants ménagers comme l'eau de Javel ne doivent pas reposer longtemps sur la surface. Si vous ne vous souvenez plus de la finition ou des matériaux constituant votre mobilier,

BOIS MASSIF HUILÉ Le bois est un matériau durable, naturel et vivant : ce qui explique les variations de grain, de couleur, de texture, la présence de nœuds. De par nature poreux, il continue à absorber et libérer de l'humidité toute sa vie durant. L'huile fait ressortir le veinage du bois et sa chaleur mais n'assure pas de résistance aux rayures. Son entretien doit être régulier pour conserver son aspect et ses propriétés. Huilez au moins une fois par an votre meuble avec de l'huile de paraffine ou de vaseline, afin de sceller les pores du bois et le rendre moins sensible aux variations de taux d'humidité. Dans le cas d'une utilisation par forte chaleur ou forte humidité, renouvelez l'application d'huile plus fréquemment. Après chaque application, laissez au bois le temps d'absorber l'huile avant toute utilisation. Époussetez régulièrement avec un chiffon sec. Nettoyez avec un chiffon humide. En cas de taches résistantes : poncez avec du papier de verre fin puis procédez à une application d'huile.

RO - CE TREBUIE SA STITI DESPRE MOBILA TA! Este important sa stiti ca culoarea mobilierului dumneavoastra se poate schimba in functie de utilizarea si de expunerea la lumina. Deasemenea, evitati sa va expuneti mobila la razele directe ale soarelui sau expunerea directa la surse de caldura pentru perioade lungi de timp, acest lucru ar putea cauza decolorare. Nu asezati niciodata obiecte umede sau fierbinti direct pe produs, deoarece suprafata mobilierului este sensibila la caldura. Pastrati cheile de asamblare pentru a strange regulat ansamblurile pentru a da stabilitatea permanenta a mobilierului dumneavoastra. Pentru a va mentine mobila curata, stergeti-o în mod regulat cu o carpa uscata. Pentru a va muta obiectele pe mobila, nu le trageți, ci ridicati-le pentru a evita orice risc de zgârieturi. Pentru a va muta piesa de mobilier, va sfatuim sa o faceti intotdeauna cu 2 sau mai multe persoane, nu-l glisati, ci ridicati-l pentru a evita orice risc de zgârieturi pe podea. Daca mobila dumneavoastra contine parti din material textil, culoarea poate varia in timp, aceasta este o reactie naturala a tesaturilor expuse la lumina soarelui. **PENTRU ÎNGRIJIREA GENERALA A MOBILIEREI DVS.:** Cand primiti mobila, asigurati-va ca o aerisiti bine, usile si sertarele deschise, intr-o camera bine ventilata. Evitati contactul cu substante pe baza de alcool, solventi, materiale abrazive, obiecte ascutite sau ascutite. Produsele de curatare de uz casnic, nu ar trebui sa stea mult timp pe suprafata mobilei. Daca nu va mai amintiti finisajul sau materialele care compun mobila dvs., nu ezitati sa sunati la serviciul nostru pentru clienti! **RO - LEMN MASIV ULEIAT** Lemnul este un material durabil, natural si viu: ceea ce explica variatiile de granulatie, culoare, textura, prezenta nodurilor. Prin natura lui, lemnul continua sa absoarba si sa elibereze umiditatea pe tot parcursul vietii sale. Uleiul scoate în evidenta granulatia lemnului si caldura acestuia, dar nu ofera rezistenta la zgârieturi. Întretinerea acestuia trebuie sa fie regulata pentru a-si pastra aspectul si proprietatile. Ungeti-va mobila cel putin o data pe an cu ulei de parafina, pentru a sigila porii lemnului si a-l face mai putin sensibil la variatiile de umiditate. In cazul utilizarii la caldura ridicata sau umiditate ridicata, reînnoiti aplicatia ulei mai des. Dupa fiecare aplicare, lasati lemnului timp sa absoarba uleiul inainte de utilizare. Desprafuiti in mod regulat cu o carpa uscata. Curatati cu o carpa usor umeda. In cazul petelor persistente: slefuiti cu hartie abraziva fina apoi aplicati ulei. Nu utilizati agenti de curatare pe baza de solventi sau abrazivi.

БГ- КАКВО ТРЯБВА ДА ЗНАЕТЕ ЗА ВАШИТЕ МЕБЕЛИ! Важно е да знаете, че цветът на вашите мебели може да се промени в зависимост от употребата и излагането на светлина. Също така избягвайте да излагате мебелите си на пряка слънчева светлина или директно на източници на топлина за дълги периоди от време, това може да доведе до обезцветяване. Никога не поставяйте мокри или горещи предмети директно върху продукта, тъй като повърхността на мебелите е чувствителна към топлина. Пазете ключовете за сглобяване, за да затягате редовно сглобките, за да осигурите постоянна стабилност на вашите мебели. За да поддържате мебелите си чисти, избърсвайте ги редовно със суха кърпа. За да изместите вещите си върху мебелите, не ги влачете, а ги повдигнете, за да избегнете всякакъв риск от надраскване. За да преместите вашата мебел, съветваме ви винаги да го правите с 2 или повече души, не я плъзгайте, а я повдигнете, за да избегнете всякакъв риск от надраскване на пода. Ако вашите мебели съдържат текстилни части, цветът може да варира с времето, това е естествена реакция на тъкани, изложени на слънчева светлина. ЗА ГЕНЕРАЛНА ГРИЖА ЗА ВАШИТЕ МЕБЕЛИ: Когато получите мебелите, уверете се, че ги проветрявате добре, вратите и чекмеджетата са отворени, в добре проветриво помещение. Избягвайте контакт с вещества на алкохолна основа, разтворители, абразивни материали, остри или заострени предмети. Домакинските почистващи препарати не трябва да остават дълго време върху повърхността на мебелите. Ако не можете да си спомните покритието или материалите, от които са изработени вашите мебели, не се колебайте да се обадите на нашия отдел за обслужване на клиенти! БГ- МАСИВНО МАСЛЕНО ДЪРВО Дървото е издържлив, естествен и жив материал: което обяснява вариациите в гранулацията, цвета, текстурата, наличието на чепове. По своята същност дървото продължава да абсорбира и освобождава влага през целия си живот. Маслото подчертава гранулацията на дървото и неговата топлина, но не осигурява устойчивост на надраскване. Поддръжката му трябва да е редовна, за да запази вида и свойствата си. Намазвайте мебелите си поне веднъж годишно с парафиново масло, за да затворите порите на дървото и да го направите по-малко чувствително към промени във влажността. Когато използвате при висока температура или висока влажност, подновявайте нанасянето на маслото по-често. След всяко нанасяне оставете дървото да абсорбира маслото преди употреба. Почиствайте редовно със суха кърпа. Почиствайте с леко влажна кърпа. В случай на упорити петна: шлайфайте с фина абразивна хартия и след това нанесете масло. Не използвайте почистващи препарати на основата на разтворители или абразиви.
